

TOWN OF ROSE – TOWN BOARD MEETING

March 9, 2026

The meeting was brought to order by Chair VandeCastle at 7:00pm.

Members Present: Chair VandeCastle, Supervisors Perez and Cutts, Clerk VandeCastle and Treasurer Gotthart.

Others Present: Beth Cutts and Mike Urban

Motion was made by Supv. Perez, seconded by Supv. Cutts, to approve the agenda as presented.

Motion carried unanimously.

Minutes of the 2/9/26 regular board meeting were read by all. Motion was made by Supv. Perez, seconded by Supv. Cutts, to accept the minutes of the 2/9/26 meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

The Treasurer Report was read and discussed by all. Motion was made by Supv. Cutts, seconded by Supv. Perez, to accept the Treasurer Report and pay the bills as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

PUBLIC INPUT: None

OLD BUSINESS: Mike rented the high lift to cut the large limbs at the Bohemian Cemetery, on Archer, by Mark Handrich's old farm and on 14th. Mike fixed a couple head stones at the cemetery that had fallen over. The sign at the cemetery does not need to be moved until the new gate is finished. Mike put up the weight limit signs on the town roads. Someone left 11 tires by the Town Forest. Mike will contact the Rod & Gun Club to see if they want them. Mike checked the rest of the trees in the township. Some limbs on Apache, 18th and Kalata's can be cut down. Supv. Cutts will be checking the roads where the utilities are going in to be sure they don't leave any road or shoulder damage. Supv. Cutts was also wondering what the rating of the bridge on 17th was after the inspection. Clerk VandeCastle will check with the Highway Department. Mike will pick up the brush by Caves' property when it warms up. Mike mentioned that 11-12 fiberglass posts were broken from the snowplow over the winter. The Board asks that the plow driver be a little more careful. Mike replaced the fiberglass posts.

Supv. Cutts is still working on an outline to aid in updating the Comprehensive Plan. The Board should begin putting together the committee to do the updating. Names were discussed and will be asked to join the committee. The committee members will be paid. The Board will discuss pay.

Chair VandeCastle spoke with Attorney Joan Olson, and the \$50-500 fine is per State Statute. Chair VandeCastle read the proposed resolution aloud that would specify the forfeitures, costs, assessments and penalties to be imposed for any violation which is alleged to have occurred under the ATV/UTV Ordinance. Supv. Cutts made the motion, seconded by Supv. Perez, to approve Resolution No. 2026-1 amending Ordinance 1-2025 to specify the forfeitures, costs, assessments and penalties to be imposed for any violation which is alleged to have occurred under this Ordinance. Motion carried by voice vote: 3 Ayes, 0 Nays, 0 Abstain, 0 absent.

NEW BUSINESS: Because the Town of Rose adopted the Room Tax Ordinance, Chair VandeCastle (also works for the Tourism Committee of Waushara County) invited the Town Board and Mike Urban to the Discover Wisconsin Premiere Part on Friday, March 27th at 6:00pm at the County Government Center in the County Board Room. The Discover Wisconsin show will air April 11th and 12th.
