

TOWN OF ROSE – TOWN BOARD MEETING

April 21, 2026

The meeting was brought to order by Chair VandeCastle at 7:13pm.

Members Present: Chair VandeCastle, Supervisors Perez and Cutts, Clerk VandeCastle and Treasurer Gotthart.

Others Present: Beth Cutts and Mike Urban

Motion was made by Supv. Cutts, seconded by Supv. Perez, to approve the agenda as presented.

Motion carried unanimously.

Minutes of the 3/9/26 regular board meeting were read by all. Motion was made by Supv. Perez, seconded by Supv. Cutts, to accept the minutes of the 3/9/26 meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Treasurer Gotthart joined the meeting at 7:19pm.

The Treasurer Report was read and discussed by all. Motion was made by Supv. Cutts, seconded by Supv. Perez, to accept the Treasurer Report and pay the bills as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

PUBLIC INPUT: None

OLD BUSINESS: The Board discussed the ice storm cleanup and what to do with the trees and brush in the ditches. Mike Urban recently had back surgery, so his son Nathan is helping with the road work. Nathan is willing to go along the roads with the chipper. Supv. Cutts and Chair VandeCastle will gather the brush into piles to make chipping easier. Supv. Perez received the map from Scott at Crackfilling Service with his recommendations for crack filling roads. The Board will discuss chip sealing at the May meeting. Mike reported that Akron Lane is breaking apart in numerous locations. Chair VandeCastle stated that the logging company has been causing some of the damage. Supv. Cutts suggested that the County do Akron Lane when they do Akron Drive since they will be right there; possibly pave the remaining .74 mile of Akron Dr. and all of Akron Ln. (.3 mile) for another LRIP project. The Board also discussed turning Akron Ln. into a gravel road. Chair VandeCastle will check with WTA to determine if there is anything the Town must do to turn the road from asphalt to gravel. Supv. Cutts made the motion, seconded by Supv. Perez, to go with Crackfilling Service's recommendations for crack filling and have them do the work not to exceed \$12,500. Motion carried unanimously. Supv. Perez will call Scott from Crackfilling Service. Chair VandeCastle will have the County come out to take a look at Akron Ln. to determine the best option.

Sharon Atkinson and Deb Johnson have agreed to join the committee to update the Comprehensive Plan. Someone will contact Mark Handrich to see if he would like to join the committee, also.

NEW BUSINESS: Chair VandeCastle presented the resolution supporting a comprehensive and sustainable transportation funding solution to passed by the Town Board. The Wisconsin Towns Association would like the Town Board to pass this resolution and send it to the legislators to show that

more funding is needed for road work. Supv. Cutts made the motion, seconded by Supv. Perez, to adopt the Resolution Supporting a Comprehensive and Sustainable Transportation Funding Solution. Motion carried unanimously. Clerk VandeCastle will send the resolution to the legislators and the WTA.

Chair VandeCastle reported on the following:

Chair VandeCastle thanked the board for all their hard work over the last few years. Everyone works really well together.

The agenda for May was discussed. The next meeting will be on May 11, 2026.

Supv. Cutts made the motion, seconded by Supv. Perez, to adjourn the meeting at 8:50pm. Motion carried.
