

TOWN OF ROSE – TOWN BOARD MEETING

June 8, 2026

The meeting was brought to order by Chair VandeCastle at 7:00pm.

Members Present: Chair VandeCastle, Supervisors Perez and Cutts, Clerk VandeCastle and Treasurer Gotthart.

Others Present: Mike Urban, Bob & Nikki Intine, and Bill Olsen

Motion was made by Supv. Cutts, seconded by Supv. Perez, to approve the agenda as presented.

Motion carried unanimously.

Minutes of the 5/11/26 Board of Review and regular board meeting were read by all. Motion was made by Supv. Perez, seconded by Supv. Cutts, to accept the minutes of the 5/11/26 meetings. Motion carried unanimously.

The Treasurer Report was read and discussed by all. Clerk VandeCastle noted that payment for a cemetery plot will be coming in the mail. Motion was made by Supv. Cutts, seconded by Supv. Perez, to accept the Treasurer Report and pay the bills as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

PUBLIC INPUT: Bill Olsen asked the Board if he could receive a fire number for his vacant property on Akron Dr. There is a shed on the property, but no other buildings. The Board referred him to the Waushara County Zoning Department.

OLD BUSINESS: Mike has about 1,000 lbs. of cold mix left to patch potholes. Most of Apache Dr. is patched. Mike inquired about Apache Dr. north of the Kolka farm before the curve to see if it will be wedged and seal coated. The Board discussed the projects that the County will be doing. Chair VandeCastle will speak with Dean Anderson to get on the schedule and be sure that the area on Apache Dr. north of the Kolka farm before the curve is done, also. Mike and his son have a lot of the brush cleaned up in the township. They plan to be done by the end of June. Paul Szczublewski pushed a lot of the brush back on 15th Rd.

Treasurer Gotthart discussed the handout regarding the court case. If anyone has any questions, Cindi can contact Donna the County.

Nothing new to report on the updates to the Comprehensive Plan. Someone will contact Mark Handrich to ask him to join the committee.

NEW BUSINESS: The County Treasurer would like the Town Board to discuss adding an online paying option for property tax payments. The Town would have to pay an additional \$350 per year for this added feature to the current tax collection software. The convenience fees would be transferred to the customer. Supv. Perez made the motion, seconded by Supv. Cutts, to pay the extra \$350 to T-Tech to make the online payment option available. Discussion followed. It was suggested that the Town charge a surcharge to recoup some of the costs. Motion carried unanimously. Treasurer Gotthart will speak with the County Treasurer about adding a surcharge and will report back to the Board next month.
